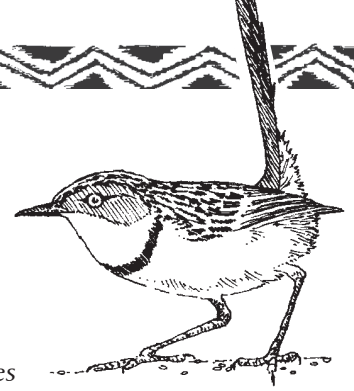

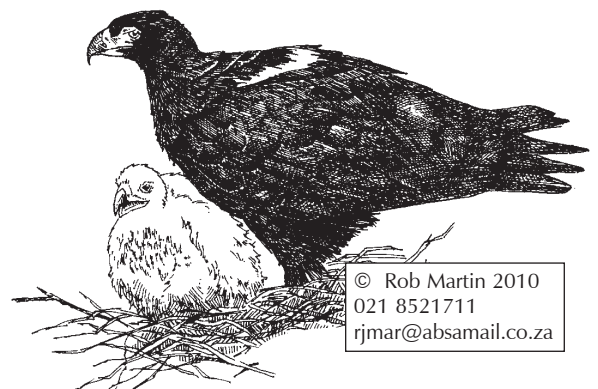

122	Cape Vulture - there used to be a roost near the Calitzdorp spa.	
135	Wahlberg's Eagle - a pair remained at Red Stone Hills for several months.	
143	Black-chested Snake-Eagle - single record from Anysberg Nature Reserve.	
183	Lesser Kestrel - there used to be a roost in Calitzdorp.	
192	Red-winged Francolin - reported from the Swartberg.	
230	Kori Bustard - reported from the Red Stone Hills area.	
286	African Snipe - a single record from MontEco Private Nature Reserve.	
315	Grey-headed Gull - occasional visitor to MontEco Private Nature Reserve.	
339	White-winged Tern - a single record from Rens Reich.	
394	Wood Owl - only known from Die Hel.	
532	(European) Sand Martin: single record from the Olifant's River.	
536	Black Saw-wing - rare visitor to Red Stone Hills.	
548	Pied Crow - occurs in Anysberg Nature Reserve.	
593	Mocking Cliff-Chat - records from Montagu and Seweweekspoort.	
660	Cinnamon-breasted Warbler - recorded from the upper slopes of the Swartberg.	
697	Chat Flycatcher - Known from Anysberg Nature Reserve.	
715	Grey Wagtail - single record from Anysberg Nature Reserve.	
805	Yellow-throated Petronia (Sparrow) - a single sighting in December 2009.	
842	African Firefinch - old record from De Rust.	
864	Dusky Indigobird - a male and several females were present for a month on Red Stone Hills.	
870	Black-throated Canary - scarce visitor to Anysberg Nature Reserve.
